

In light of COVID-19, the following are measures that Ross Painting is taking to protect our employees' and customers' safety.

- Employees are required to stay at home if they experience any symptoms of respiratory illness and or fever.
- We are requiring that any clients who may be experiencing symptoms themselves postpone their appointments or scheduled projects.
- Each of our crews and our office team is operating independently of one another to minimize contact and stay in compliance with current guidelines, which recommend avoiding any gatherings of more than 10 people.
- Employees have been instructed to wash their hands frequently.
- Employees have been instructed to avoid physical contact with each other and clients as much as possible.
- Painters are instructed to not share Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- We have increased the cleaning and sanitation of our trucks and equipment
- For those team members who do meet with customers, stand at least 6 feet away from other people and avoid shaking hands.
- We are scheduling as many exterior projects as weather conditions will allow in order to minimize time inside of clients' homes. We are also prioritizing projects taking place in vacant homes or buildings.
- We are still doing exterior painting quotes that require little or no contact, and we are willing to do some interior quotes as well with only 1 person from our team coming to your house. He would keep the recommended 6ft distance from household members and need little to no contact once inside. Please contact us to learn more.
